2	CAREER SENIOR EXECUTIVE SERVICE EM-
3	PLOYEES.
4	(a) Report.—Not later than 90 days after the end
5	of each fiscal year beginning with fiscal year 2024, the
6	head of each agency of the executive branch of Govern-
7	ment shall submit a report to Congress on performance
8	awards paid to career appointees of such agency. Each
9	such report shall include, with respect to any performance
10	award paid during the most recently ended fiscal year—
11	(1) the total number of performance awards
12	paid to career appointees of the agency;
13	(2) the name, job title, and annual rate of pay
14	of any career appointee paid a performance award;
15	(3) the amount of each performance award so
16	paid; and
17	(4) the appropriations accounts from which
18	amounts were used to pay such a performance
19	award.
20	(b) Definitions.—In this section—
21	(1) the term "career appointee" has the mean-
22	ing given that term in section 3132(a) of title 5,
23	United States Code; and
24	(2) the term "performance award" includes any
25	performance award paid by the Government, includ-
26	ing any bonus or award (including retention and re-
