
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for NW 56th Street Grading, Widening, and Surfacing, Lancaster County, Nebraska, First Congressional District in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Lancaster County, Nebraska, located at 555 S. 10<sup>th</sup> Street, Room 110, Lincoln, Nebraska 68508. The funding would be used for grading, widening, and surfacing of NW 56th Street from W. Holdredge Street to I-80.
