I am requesting funding for the Randolph Street Rehabilitation Project in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Lincoln located at 555 S. 10<sup>th</sup> Street Suite 203, Lincoln, Nebraska 68508.

The funding would be used for major street rehabilitation along 1.25 miles of Randolph Street, a corridor that provides east-west connectivity through the City of Lincoln, serving approximately 7,200 vehicles per day with 2.3% being commercial trucks. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because improving the transportation network and providing safe, efficient and reliable facilities is essential to attracting businesses, supporting commerce, and providing residents, commuters, and visitors with mobility solutions. These investments help to provide locals with employment and education opportunities for our economic interests to grow.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C 5305(a)(2). I certify that I have no financial interest in this project, and neither does anyone in my immediate family.
