Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for Tilden Downtown Revitalization in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Tilden located at PO Box 37, 205 S. Center St., Tilden, NE 68781. The funding would be used to replace approximately 855 linear feet of ADA-compliant sidewalk, reconstruct failing crosswalk intersections, and upgrade storm water drainage systems to alleviate persistent downtown flooding issues. It is part of a comprehensive Downtown Revitalization effort aimed at rehabilitating critical and aging public infrastructure and water mains located in the heart of Tilden, Nebraska.

This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it would remove barriers to accessing downtown businesses, especially for elderly, disabled, and other vulnerable residents. Investment in the Downtown Tilden Revitalization project will strengthen the city's business district and ensure that this community can continue to grow and sustain its population within Nebraska's First Congressional District.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 USC 5305(a)(5).
